## **HOMEWORK**

**Reading:** Now that the brighter evenings are here, please do not forget about reading. While it is important that children get outside, it is also important that they complete their homework and continue to read every night.

## **SCREEN TIME**

If you are allowing Screen Time at home, please make sure your child is doing something worthwhile. **NESSY** is a valuable program and, with consistent practice, will help every child to read, spell and write.

## **SAFETY REMINDERS**

**DROP OFF AND PICK UP:** Traffic congestion in the morning and afternoon is causing significant problems as the traffic is backed up along Newington Avenue. **Can I ask all parents/carers to park your car and walk to the door to drop off or collect children. Please do not park in the middle of the road. In the interest of Health and Safety PLEASE DO NOT DRIVE INTO THE SCHOOL GROUNDS.**

**DOGS:** Can I ask you **NOT** to bring dogs into the school office or close to the school entrance when collecting children. We have a number of anxious children and adults.

**CARS:** Could we ask you to respect parked cars in the school grounds while dropping off and collecting your children.

## **AFTERSCHOOL CARE/WAITING ROOM/BREAKFAST CLUB**

**Breakfast Club** runs everyday for just £1.50 a day. Your child can enjoy a healthy breakfast in school from 8.00 am. This is an ideal service for parents who need care due to work commitments. Children cannot wait outside unsupervised.

**Waiting Room** runs Monday to Thursday for just £2.00 a day. This service is available for P1, P2 and P3 children who have older siblings or working parents, Children must be collected at 2.40 pm at the front entrance.

**Afterschool Care** runs Monday to Friday from 2.45 pm to 5.30 pm. Your child can stay until 5.30 pm for £10.00 per day for one child, £16.00 per day for two children and £24.00 per day for three children. Your child can also stay until 4 pm for £6 per day. All the above can be booked and paid on the School Money App.
