## AFTERSCHOOL CARE/WAITING ROOM/BREAKFAST CLUB

**Breakfast Club** runs everyday for just £1.50 a day. Your child can enjoy a healthy breakfast in school from 8.00 am. This is an ideal service for parents who need care due to work commitments. Children cannot wait outside unsupervised.

**Waiting Room** runs Monday to Thursday for just £2.00 a day. This service is available for P1, P2 and P3 children who have older siblings or working parents, Children must be collected at 2.40 pm at the front entrance.

**Afterschool Care** runs Monday to Friday from 2.45 pm to 5.30 pm. Your child can stay until 5.30 pm for £10.00 per day for one child, £16.00 per day for two children and £24.00 per day for three children. Your child can also stay until 4 pm for £6 per day. All the above can be booked and paid on the School Money App.
